This project is an ethnography of the category of "men who have sex with men" (MSM). It problematizes modern biomedical and sexual citizenship within the overlapping contexts of the HIV/AIDS epidemic and the anti-drug war of the Philippines. Its focus is on PrEP Pilipinas, the first community-based peer-driven pilot delivery of HIV pre-exposure prophylaxis drugs in the world for MSM. It involves ethnographic fieldwork conducted from September 2017 to August 2018.
